

PROTOCOL Blocked Drain

Purpose

To describe the activities required to clear a drain back-up without crosscontamination to production areas

<u>Equipment</u> <u>PPE</u>

Black plastic bag Safety Shoes
Black scrapers Rubber Gloves
Black buckets Black dustcoat

Black grip squeegee

Product

Shureclean 1:100

Delladet sanitizer 1:100 ready to use in spray bottle

Instructions

- Notify a quality representative in the area
- If production is in operation, the affected area should be shut down immediately
- Isolate the area with danger tape and avoid any unnecessary through traffic
- Remove all pallets, supplies and ingredients from the area and assess for water contamination
- Reject any exposed product
- Correct the issue, ensuring that any equipment brought into the production area by the plumbing contractor is hygienically clean
- Discard any drain waste into a refuge bag
- Clean and sanitize the floor and any surface that came into contact with the drain material. This is to include the shoes of people involved
- Production may resume once the area has been inspected by a quality representative
- Clean and sanitize the cleaning equipment and store in a secure area apart from normal production cleaning equipment
